Overview

Responsibilities

- **Continue ongoing research of current tools and content on the topic** – SHALVA aims to integrate tools and education that already exist through partnerships and collaboration. Research has been ongoing and now pulling together key content is critical
- **Design and write user-friendly and engaging content** – build out each module based on research, desired outcomes, and ongoing feedback from stakeholders and target population
- **Shape in-person programming** – work with Program Manager to create valuable in-person events to build community and enhance education
