





What is defamation?





LIBEL



1 Statement must be a provably false fact (as distinguished from opinion)



Fact vs. Opinion



"the Court concludes that Phillips's statements that Sandmann blocked' him and 'wouldn't allow [him] to retreat' are objectively unverifiable and thus unactionable opinions."









2 Statement must have a defamatory meaning (harm to reputation)

In the Shadiness Statement McGowan spoke in reference to Baez's representation of McGowan in the McGowan Virginia Case and his subsequent representation of Weinstein in the Weinstein New York Case. A statement that an attorney lacks integrity in the discharge of his professional duties and accuses him misconduct can be defamation per se. Missner v, Clifford, 393 Ill. App. 3d 751 (2009). Baez is right to claim that an allegation of disloyalty or having been "bought off" could damage him as an attorney. But when read in the context of the statement, it is also opinion. She states, in the context of learning that her attorneys in her case - where she believes Weinstein had planted cocaine - were now Weinstein's lawyers an opinion and feeling that "my instinct was my lawyers had been bought off" (emphasis added).

The Court finds as a matter of law that the statement, "I'm not even surprised by the level of fuckery going on here. @thedailybeast" is not defamation per se. The Court offers no definition of the term "fuckery", but it is clearly a matter of opinion.
